"How Will You Believe?" (John 5:31-47)

Despite all of the evidence and multiple witnesses, the Jewish leaders refused to believe in Jesus. Even with their thorough study of the OT, they had missed Jesus. We are warned not to let our pride, self-worship, and preconceived ideas of who we think God should be keep us from missing Jesus and the life he offers.
